School Calendar. We are aligned with TUSD. Please see the calendar on our website for holidays, non-school days and special events. Important dates are conveyed monthly via our newsletter and the information board at the main entrance.

What to bring to school:

PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING

- An extra change of clothes for your child in a ziplock bag and a reusable water bottle (optional). **Please do not send backpacks, toys from home, or snacks** (unless your child has an allergy related dietary restriction).
- **If staying for lunch** please bring a lunch box with an ice pack if you need food to stay cold (optional). We cannot reheat meals for your child. **Please do not send Pistachio, Peanut, Brazil or Cashew products in your child's lunch as these are the allergies we have onsite this year.**
- **If your child stays for a nap**, please send a small blanket and pillow in a bag. We provide the nap sheets. The nap supplies will be given to you Thursday/Friday to wash and return Monday/Tuesday morning.

Payments: Online payments are made via Procure. Check payments may be dropped in the "payments" mailbox on the inside of the office door.

Emergency kit: Please bring a gallon zip lock bag labeled with your child's name with several of their favorite non-perishable food items and a note from you or a family photo if you wish. We have water and food onsite for 3 days.

What to wear: We get **MESSY**. **Please do not send your child in clothes that you do not want to get dirty and/or stained.** Our curriculum is based around hands-on learning, independence and sensory experiences. Your child may get wet, muddy, get paint on them and more. CLOSED TOED SHOES are required. Croc/Native type shoes are perfect.

Please sign your child in and out daily: This is a legal requirement. The school receives a citation and a fine if you miss a sign in or out. Please sign your child in and out on an classroom iPad kiosk using the PIN you were sent via Procure OR via the Procure app on your personal device.

Communication: The BEST WAY to contact us is to SEND A MESSAGE through Procure. Based on the day, emails and voicemails may not get checked until the end of the day. Please sign up for text messages via the invitation you received upon enrollment. We send a monthly newsletter that contains information and the calendar for the upcoming month. Newsletters are sent to the email address you have in Procure. Please check your spam folder if you do not receive them.

Volunteer Requirements/Guardians on site: To volunteer at FPS Community Care Licensing requires us to have your immunization records on file. Please submit verification from your physician of MMR, TDap, Covid and Influenza.

Family Handbook: Please familiarize yourself with our current Family Handbook which can be found on our website on the Enrollment and Rates page.

Drop Off & Pick Up: Drop off times are 8 & 9am. If you are more than 5 mins late, you may have to wait a few minutes to be let in since the teachers are supervising children. Pick up's are 12, 1, 2 and 3pm. If you are more than 5 minutes late, your child will be waiting in the office.
